**RE: SUSTAINABLE COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL BUILDINGS
INCENTIVE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS Regina's Vision includes being Canada's most SUSTAINABLE community; and

WHEREAS our Official Community Plan is currently being reviewed and updated via the Design Regina process; and

WHEREAS the design, construction and operation of buildings is a major factor in a city's energy use; and

WHEREAS Regina does not currently have an official program to incent or encourage "green" or environmentally sustainable buildings.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that City Council instructs the Administration to prepare a report, as part of The Design Regina process, which:
