Fun Facts

- Total cubic metres of concrete used in facility: **3600m³** That's like **45,000 wheelbarrows full!**
- Total water volume: **more than 2.6 million litres**
- Saltwater-generated chlorine
- Enclosed Waterslide speed: **35 km/hr**
- Open Waterslide speed: **30 km/hr**
- Total capacity: **800 people**

Facility Features

- 25m circular leisure pool

- Accessible, all gender washrooms and changerooms
- Accessible and inclusive playground and spray pad beside the facility



Sustainability

Sustainability features include a regenerative pool water filtration system, a high-efficient water heating plant, solar panels and the City's first recirculating spray pad.

Solar panels: 30% of the energy for the facility comes from the solar panels.

Accessibility



Designed with accessibility in mind: Wascana Pool is one of the most accessible and inclusive outdoor aquatic facilities in the country.

- Individual, all gender, accessible washrooms and changerooms
- Zero depth entry and mechanical lifts into all pools
- Signage includes braille, tactile markings and a tactile map
- Accessible side by side medium slides
- Aqua wheelchairs and aqua walkers available
- Accessible playground and spray pad beside the facility
