

For the City of Regina Facebook Contest Submission Rules

Term

The time to submit entries to the City for consideration for inclusion in the City of Regina Instagram Contest begins on May 8, 2025 and ends on May 11, 2025. ALL SUBMISSIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY MIDNIGHT, May 11, 2025 to be considered. Winner be selected on May 12,

Who May Participate

Participation is open only to individuals who have reached the age of majority in their jurisdiction of residence at the time of submission.

How to Participate

To enter, Comment on the contest post on Facebook and name this years Emergency Preparedness Week's theme: "Be prepared. Know your risks."

1. Submissions must be in digital format. Only online entries will be eligible. No print or film submissions will be accepted. All digital files must be less than 5 megabytes and must be in JPEG or .jpg format.
2. Submissions must not, in the sole and unfettered discretion of the City, contain obscene, provocative, defamatory, sexually explicit, or otherwise objectionable or inappropriate content. Any Submission that is considered by the City in its sole and absolute discretion to be obscene, pornographic, libelous, hate speech or otherwise objectionable, in whole or in part, will be disqualified.
3. Submissions must be the entrant's own, produced work and may not feature or focus on any material owned or controlled by third parties (unless the entrant can provide written documentation of permission to use any materials owned by a third party as set forth below or in a form and substance determined by the City in its sole discretion).
4. Participants must provide upon request all appropriate clearances, permissions and releases (including but not limited to releases from all persons appearing in the Submission, location releases, and releases from all creative consultants or others who assisted in the creation of the Submission) for the Submission in a form and substance determined by the City in its sole discretion (in the event an entrant cannot provide all required releases, the City reserves the right to disqualify the applicable Submission).

Submissions that, in the City's good faith judgment, violates the requirements set out herein will be disqualified. Submissions must be received by the end of the term specified.

Prizes

There is 1 (one) prizes (the "Prize") available to be won, consisting of 1 Emergency Preparedness kit and backpack.

Approximate retail value of the Prize is **\$200 CAD**. The Prize must be accepted as awarded and may not be substituted, transferred or redeemed for cash or otherwise. The City reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to substitute a prize of greater or equivalent monetary value if the Prize, or part thereof, cannot be awarded as described for any reason.

How to Win

On May 12, 2025 at City Hall located at 2476 Victoria Avenue, Regina Saskatchewan, at 12:00 p.m. CST, a random draw will be conducted from among all eligible entries received during the Contest Period for the purpose of selecting a Prize winner. Odds of being selected depend on the number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period.

Prize Claim Conditions

In order to be declared a winner, the selected entrant must: (i) respond to notification of selection; (ii) sign a written declaration and release form, releasing the City from any liability in connection with this Contest or the use, misuse, awarding or possession of any prize (the "Release"); and, (iii) otherwise comply with these Terms and Conditions. Return of the Prize, or any part thereof, or winner notification as undeliverable, inability to reach selected entrant or failure of selected entrant to respond to notification within two (2) business days of first attempt by the City, failure to provide a valid email address, failure to provide proof of eligibility (if requested), release documents, or other required documentation in a timely manner, or other non-compliance with these Terms and Conditions may result in disqualification, forfeiture of the Prize, or part thereof, and, at the City's sole discretion, selection of an alternate eligible entrant for the forfeited Prize, or part thereof, in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, who will be subject to disqualification in the same manner.

Submission Intellectual Property

Participants who incorporate any intellectual property or material owned by a third party into his or her Submission does so at his or her own risk. If City is duly notified that any element of an entrant's Submission infringes upon the rights of another person and/or receives a legally valid request to remove the affected Submission from consideration because of such infringement, such Submission shall be removed.

Upon submission, participants acknowledge and agree that any and all photos submitted are for use on City of Regina website and promotional materials and that the photos are being provided without compensation or notice. All negatives and positives, together with the prints and other derivatives shall constitute the property, solely and completely, of the City of Regina.

Releases

If the Submission contains any material or elements that are not owned by the entrant and/or which are subject to the rights of third parties, and/or if any persons appear in the photograph, the participant is responsible for obtaining, prior to submission of the photograph, any and all releases and consents necessary to permit the exhibition and use of the photograph in the manner set forth herein without additional compensation. If any person appearing in any photograph is under the age of majority in their state/province/territory of residence the signature of a parent or legal guardian is required on each release.

Representations, Warranties and Indemnities

All participants represent and warrant as follows: (i) except as set forth herein, the Submission is the entrant's own, produced by entrant; (ii) the Submission does not contain any computer virus (as applicable), is otherwise uncorrupted, is wholly original with entrant, and as of the date of submission, is not the subject of any actual or threatened litigation or claim; (iii) the Submission does not and will not violate or infringe upon the intellectual property rights or other rights of any third party; and (iv) the Submission does not and will not violate any applicable laws, and is not and will not be defamatory or libelous. Each entrant hereby agrees to indemnify and hold the City harmless from and against any and all third party claims, actions or proceedings of any kind and from any and all damages, liabilities, costs and expenses relating to or arising out of any breach or alleged breach of any of the warranties, representations or agreements of entrant hereunder.

Grant of License Rights

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and legal sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, participants hereby irrevocably and unconditionally grant to the City, its successors and assigns the right (but not the obligation) to use entrant's Submission in whole or in part, to reproduce, distribute, display and create derivative works of the entrant's Submission in connection with the Photo Contest for no additional compensation in any and all languages, by any and all means, media, devices, processes and technology now known or hereafter devised, in perpetuity throughout the universe at no charge to the City.
