PUBLIC NOTICE – ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT APPLICATION


Regina City Council intends to consider a Zoning Bylaw Amendment Application in relation to the properties identified and as shown on the map below:

Legal Description: Lots 21-25, Block 303, Plan OLD33

Civic Address: 1720 12th Ave

Current Zoning: DCD-D- Direct Control District Downtown

Proposed Zone: C- Contract Zone



REASON - The applicant proposes to rezone property located within the Downtown neighbourhood from Downtown Direct Control District Zone (D-DCD) to Contract Zone in order to pursue a surface parking lot. The surface parking lot is associated with a proposed commercial development (Regina Food Bank) on the adjacent property 1881 Broad Street. The purpose of the Contract Zone is to accommodate the proposed developments (surface parking lot), as they are not allowed within the D-DCD Zone, and to address soil contamination which is a site constraint.
