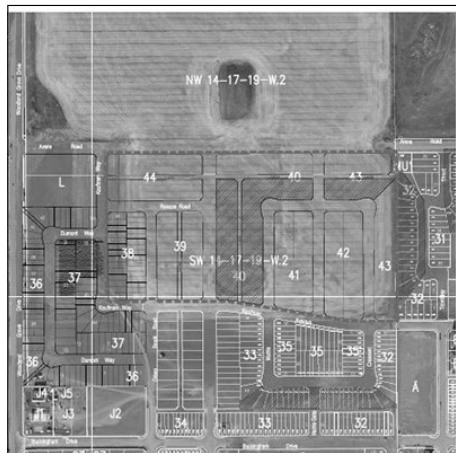

## PUBLIC NOTICE – DEVELOPMENT LEVY BYLAW AMENDMENT

### PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 2022-15

Regina City Council intends to consider an amendment to *The Development Levy Bylaw, 2011* which will affect land within the Tower Crossing Secondary Plan, as set out in Part B.15 of *Design Regina: The Official Community Plan* Bylaw No. 2022-15.

**REASON** – The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend *The Development Levy Bylaw, 2011* to make text amendments that will allow for collection of an Area Servicing Agreement Fee upon the development of lands within the Plan area and to exempt certain lands within the Plan area from the application of Greenfield Area Development Charges.
