NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER SHORT-TERM DEBT FINANCING AND BORROWING BYLAW

The City of Regina hereby gives notice, pursuant to sections 101 and 102 of *The Cities Act* and the Public Notice Policy Bylaw, Bylaw No. 2003-8, of its intention to consider short-term borrowing for operating expenditures of up to \$20 million including borrowing up to \$1 million for a procurement/purchasing card program. This debt is to fund ongoing operating expenditures.

The particulars of the report on the short-term borrowing will be considered by the Finance and Administration Committee on January 15, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. and then by City Council on January 29, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. The details of the short-term borrowing bylaw will be considered at the February 26, 2020 City Council meeting at 1:30 p.m. All meetings are at Henry Baker Hall, City Hall.
