PUBLIC NOTICE TO CONSIDER A SPECIAL TAX FOR ALLEY MAINTENANCE

The City of Regina hereby gives notice, pursuant to Section 275(3) of *The Cities Act* and *The Public Notice Policy Bylaw, 2020*, Bylaw No. 2020-28 of its intention to implement the 2026 special tax for alley maintenance. A special tax is levied annually for the maintenance and reconstruction of alleys throughout the city.

The report proposes a fee of \$4.33 per foot for asphalt alleys and \$3.25 per foot for gravel alleys. These amounts are payable by properties abutting a legal alley either on its rear or flank based on assessable frontage. The tax proposes raising \$5,910,158 in 2026.

The recommendation for the proposed special tax will be considered by City Council as part of the City's Budgets by Regina City Council at its Budget meetings December 15, 2025 to December 19, 2025, with meetings commencing at 9:00 a.m. at Henry Baker Hall, City Hall. This item may also be considered at subsequent meetings of Regina City Council in the Henry Baker Hall, Main Floor City Hall.

Persons wishing to speak as a delegation to City Council at the December 15-19, 2025 budget meeting must register by completing a delegation registration form at [Regina.ca/register](https://regina.ca/register) to request to address City Council/Committee. The deadline to register as a delegation for the December 15-19, 2025 City Council budget meeting is Thursday, December 11, 2025 at 12:00 p.m.

In order to register as a delegation to a City Council meeting agenda item, a written brief is required to be submitted at the time of registration, subject to the same registration deadline. NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER THE REALLOCATION OF EXISTING LONG-TERM DEBT, NEW LONG-TERM DEBT, AND THE CALCULATION TO DETERMINE THE DEBT LIMIT IN THE 2026-2027 BUDGET DELIBERATIONS REPORT

The City of Regina hereby gives notice, pursuant to sections 101 and 102 of *The Cities Act* and *The Public Notice Policy Bylaw, Bylaw No. 2020-28*, of its intention to consider in the 2026-2027 Budget Deliberations report reallocating a maximum principal amount of \$20 million of debt proceeds which were originally allocated to the Water Network Expansion Project and the Unfunded Development Charge Projects under *Bylaw 2025-55 (The Water Network Expansion Project and Unfunded Development Charge Projects Sinking Fund Debenture Bylaw, 2025)* to the Indoor Aquatic Facility. The amendment to *Bylaw 2025-55*, to add the Indoor Aquatic Facility as an additional project in which the City may use the debenture proceeds, will be brought forward to the February 25, 2026, City Council Meeting.

The City of Regina also gives notice of its intention to consider in the 2026-2027 Budget Deliberations report borrowing a maximum principal amount of \$156.4 million for the Indoor Aquatic Facility, \$13.8 million for the Geothermal Heating Facility, and \$60 million for the Northwest Regional Wastewater Lift Station and the Westerra Wastewater Lift Station over the course of the three years.

The City of Regina also gives notice of its intention to consider in the 2026-2027 Budget Deliberations report a request to seek approval from the Saskatchewan Municipal Board to net the sinking fund balance from debt when calculating and comparing debt to the approved debt limit.

The particulars of the 2026-2027 Budget Deliberations report will be considered by City Council from December 15, 2025 to December 19, 2025 with meetings starting at 9:00 am and may also be considered at subsequent meetings. Citizens who want to address City Council on December 15, 2025 to December 19, 2025 may attend the meetings via teleconference or in person. To attend Council, you must register by completing the online form on [Regina.ca/register](https://regina.ca/register) to request to address City Council on these matters. A written brief is required to present at the Council meeting. The deadline to register is no later than noon on Thursday, December 11, 2025.

The amendment bylaw to reallocate existing debt will be presented to City Council on February 25, 2026. Citizens who wish to address City Council on February 25, 2026 may attend the meetings via teleconference or in person. To address Council, you must register by completing the online form on [Regina.ca/register](https://regina.ca/register) to request to address City Council on these matters. A written brief is required to present at the Council meeting. The deadline to register as a delegation for the February 25, 2026 City Council meeting is no later than noon on Monday, February 23, 2026.

All meetings are held in Henry Baker Hall at City Hall. If attending by teleconference you must provide the telephone number you will be using to call into the meeting with, when registering. You will receive meeting details and instructions after you have confirmed your attendance for the meeting.
