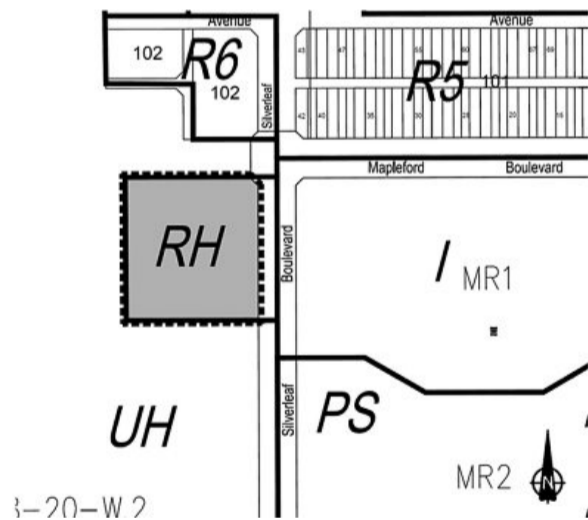
PUBLIC NOTICE - ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT

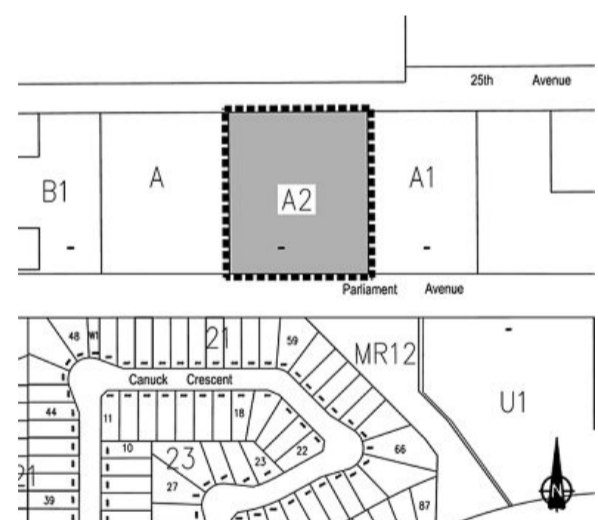
PUBLIC NOTICE - ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT
