NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER CHANGES TO *THE PROCEDURE BYLAW*

The City of Regina hereby gives notice, pursuant to sections 55.1, 101 and 102 of *The Cities Act* and *The Public Notice Policy Bylaw*, Bylaw No. 2007-9, of its intention to consider a bylaw which would amend Bylaw No. 9004, being *The Procedure Bylaw*.

City Council will be considering amendments to *The Procedure Bylaw*, Bylaw No. 9004 at its Wednesday, June 9, 2021, meeting at 1 p.m. in Henry Baker Hall, City Hall. The bylaw may also be considered at subsequent meetings of City Council. The amendments will include the following mandatory requirement:

1. Every delegation wishing to appear before Council shall:
 - (a) Submit a letter to the City Clerk requesting to appear as a delegation including the date of the meeting at which they wish to appear, the subject or topic to be discussed, the name and correct mailing address of the spokesperson, and telephone number where the representative of the delegation can be reached during the day; and
 - (b) Submit a brief clearly setting out the full text of their presentation and the request being made of Council.
2. When the spokesperson appears before Council, he or she may either make the presentation submitted pursuant to (1)(b) or provide a verbal summary of that presentation and must verbally state for the record where they reside.
