## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER CHANGES TO LONG-TERM DEBT AND GUARANTEE FOR REGINA EXHIBITION ASSOCIATION LIMITED

The City of Regina hereby gives notice, pursuant to sections 101 and 102 of *The Cities Act* and *The Public Notice Policy Bylaw*, Bylaw No. 2020-28, of its intention to consider a report and bylaw to change the Regina Exhibition Association Limited's credit facilities under *The Regina Exhibition Association Limited Borrowing and Guarantee Bylaw*, Bylaw 2015-25. The reason for the change is to provide Regina Exhibition Association Limited flexibility in meeting operating needs with cashflow concerns as it continues to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic.

The particulars of the report will be considered by the Executive Committee on May 17, 2023, at 9 a.m. and then by City Council on May 24, 2023 at 1 p.m. If approved to go forward, the borrowing/guarantee bylaw will be considered by City Council at a subsequent meeting.

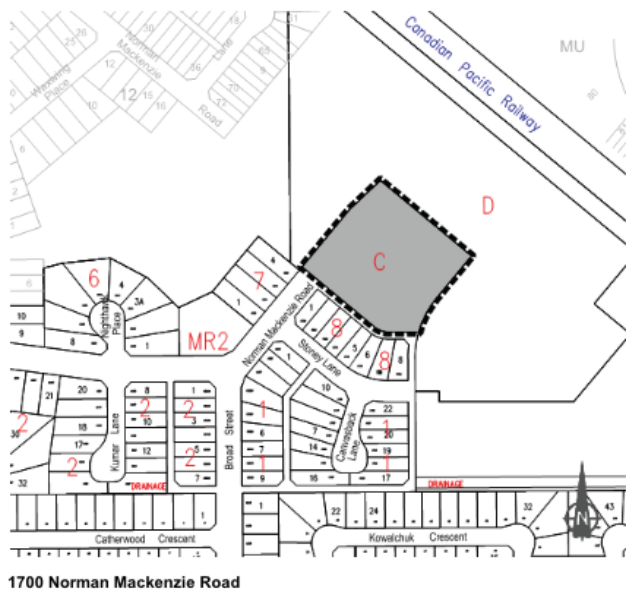
### ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENTS

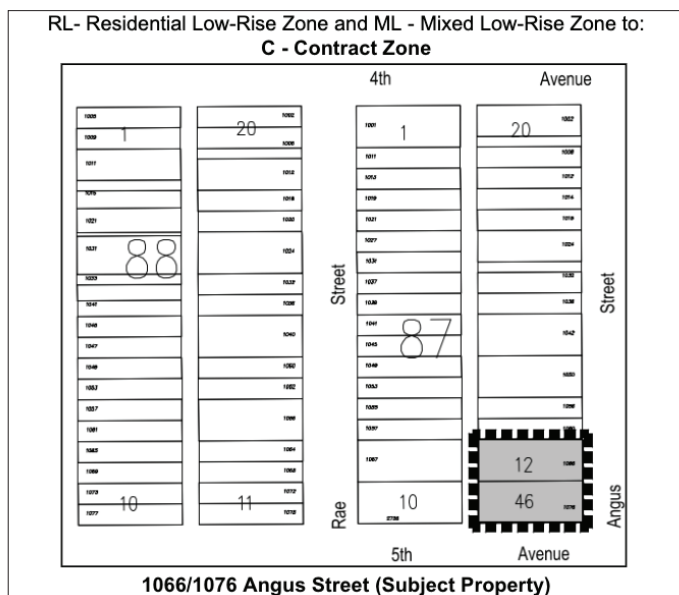

### ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT:

**1066/1076 ANGUS STREET**

Regina City Council intends to consider the following amendment to *Regina Zoning Bylaw*, 2019: rezone properties located at 1066 and 1076 Angus Street, legally described as Lot 46 Blk/Par 87 Plan No 102263239 Extension 0 and Lot 12 Blk/Par 87 Plan No OLD33 Extension 0, respectively, to C – Contract Zone.



**REASON** – The proposed rezoning will accommodate a high-density mixed-use building that includes 30 residential dwelling units and, on the main level, community amenity space. Further, the rezoning supports a reduced minimum on-site parking requirement, as the Proponent is pursuing the proposed development as an affordable housing project where the anticipated parking needs are less than a typical market rate development.

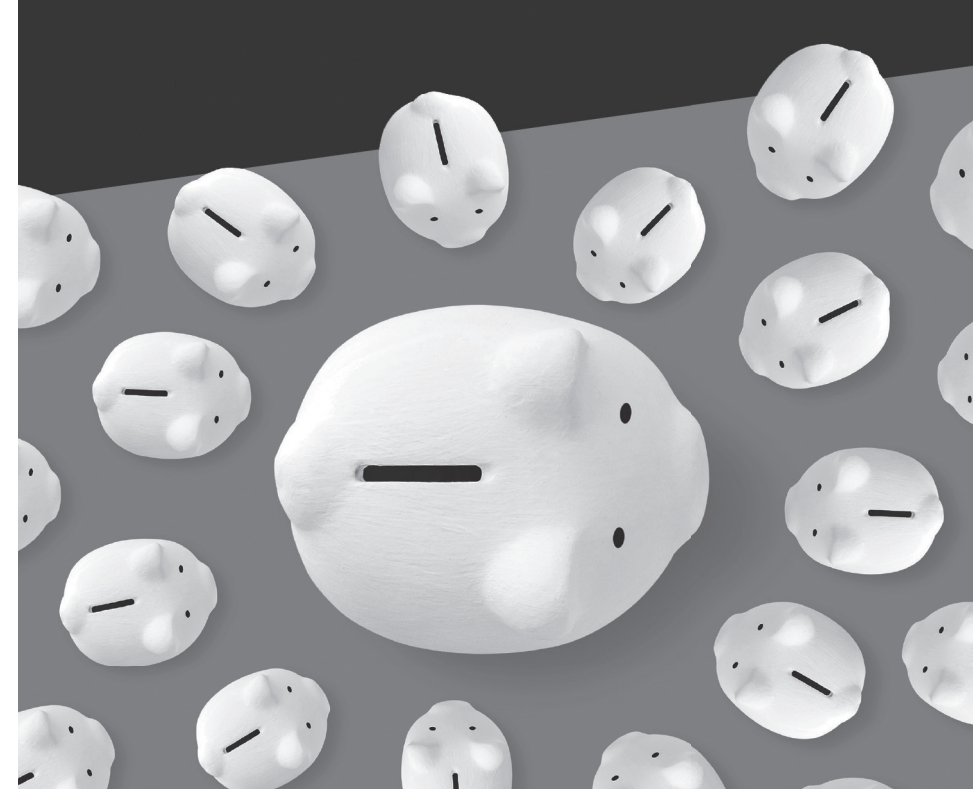
