CONCEPT PLAN AMENDMENT, ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT AND DISCRETIONARY USE APPLICATION

Regina City Council intends to consider the following amendments to the Westerra Concept Plan, *Regina Zoning Bylaw*, 2019, and a Discretionary Use application:

 Amend a portion of the Westerra Concept Plan from Main Street Retail to Medium Density Residential, rezone a portion of West Market Street to from MH – Mixed High Rise to RL – Residential Low Rise and allow for a planned group of dwellings located at 1501 West Market Street.

Reason: The proposal located at 1501 West Market Street intends to accommodate medium density residential housing units on Parcels 1 and 3 along the east side of West Market Street.



- Must have a local office in the City



OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN AND ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENTS

Regina City Council intends to consider the following amendments to Design Regina: Official Community Plan Bylaw 2013-48 and the Regina Zoning Bylaw, 2019:

1. Amend the *Design Regina: Official Community Plan Bylaw 2013-48* Map 1 Growth Map from Future Long-Term Growth to New Employment Lands for the subject property and rezone the lands to I- Institutional and UH - Urban Holding.

Reason: The west portion of the subject property (84.061 hectares) is proposed to be rezoned to I-Institutional to accommodate a Long-Term Care Facility. The remaining east portion (74.28 hectares) will be rezoned to UH-Urban Holding for future development. An amendment to *Design Regina: Official Community Plan Bylaw 2013-48* is also required to designate the subject land as a *New Employment Area.*
