

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER CASUAL AND ELECTED OFFICIALS PENSION PLAN CHANGES

The City of Regina hereby gives notice, pursuant to sections 101 and 102 of *The Cities Act* and *The Public Notice Policy Bylaw, Bylaw No. 2020-28*, of its intention to consider amendments to the *City of Regina Casual Employees' Superannuation and Elected Officials Money Purchase Pension Plan* (the Plan) contained in Bylaw No. 8589, *A Bylaw of the City of Regina Concerning a Plan for Certain Employees and Elected Officials*. The amendments modernize the governance structure of the Plan consolidating both the Casual Employees and Elected Officials plans into one unified Plan text, including moving the Plan text from Bylaw No. 8589 and repealing Bylaw No. 8589 and removing the maximum contribution age of 65 for all members. The particulars of the report and Bylaw to repeal Bylaw No. 8589 will be considered by **City Council on June 10, 2026, at 1:00 pm** and may also be considered at subsequent meetings. The City Council meeting is held in Henry Baker Hall, City Hall and citizens may attend via teleconference or in person.

Citizens who want to address **City Council on June 10, 2026**, must register by completing the online form on [Regina.ca/register](https://regina.ca/register) to request to address City Council on these matters. The deadline to register is no later than noon on **June 8, 2026**. A written brief is required to present at a Council meeting. You will receive meeting details and instructions after you have confirmed your attendance for the meeting.
