The City of Regina recognizes the efforts and achievements of an individual, community group or organization to educate, promote and enlighten the citizens of Regina about its heritage.

Award Categories and Criteria

- **Education:** this award recognizes endeavours that enhance public understanding and increased appreciation of Regina's heritage and heritage-related issues. For example, projects may include publications, exhibitions, lectures, tours, plays and commemorative events.
- **Keith Knox Heritage Award for Youth:** this award recognizes the special contribution of non-professionals under the age of 25.
- **George Bothwell Service to Public:** this awards recognizes exceptional volunteer involvement and outstanding commitment to heritage activities that enrich community life in Regina

Submission Requirements

- Five hard copies of the nomination package must be received at Regina City Hall no later than October 15.
- In addition to the application form, include one copy of any associated or appropriate illustrative materials, included publications, related photographs (minimum 300 dpi), brochures, media coverage and other materials. Total maximum of 15 items/images for supporting documentation.
- All attachments or supporting documents need to be listed and numbered according to this system:
