Bird Friendly Regina Membership Tiers

Bird Friendly Regina membership is organized into three tiers, each playing an important role in helping our community protect and celebrate birds. Whether you want to take on a leadership role, collaborate occasionally, or simply stay informed, there is a place for you in our flock!

Tier 1: Committee Members (Highest level of involvement – Ongoing commitment)

Committee Members form the core of Bird Friendly Regina. This group of dedicated volunteers leads projects, organizes initiatives, and helps guide the direction of our work. This tier is best for those who can commit consistent time and energy to advancing Bird Friendly Regina’s mission. You will be expected to meet 4+ times per year (mainly virtual). Within these meetings you will actively participate in discussions, planning, decision-making, and help participate in events, campaigns, and community engagement. This is an exciting way to share your ideas, collaborate with others, and help shape the future of bird conservation in Regina.



Tier 2: Community Partners & Special Advisors (Moderate involvement – Participate as needed)

This tier includes relevant organizations, clubs, nonprofits, or businesses (Community Partners) and individuals with expertise (Special Advisors) who want to support Bird Friendly Regina without the regular commitment of full committee membership. These members are always welcome to attend Bird Friendly Regina meetings, share ideas, and provide feedback. Community Partners and Special Advisors are not expected to attend regular meetings but may be invited to participate or provide input when their skills or perspectives are valuable.



Tier 3: General Members (Low commitment – Stay connected and informed)

General Membership is ideal for individuals who want to support Bird Friendly Regina and stay informed about local bird-friendly initiatives, but who may not have the time to participate actively. This tier is a great starting point for anyone who loves birds and wants to be part of our growing network of supporters. As a General Member you will receive updates and invitations from Bird Friendly Regina, have the option to join or volunteer at specific events or community projects, and stay connected to bird-friendly news and opportunities in Regina.
