How to start a community garden in your neighbourhood

**Read the Community Gardens Policy** 



Look for a location(s) in your neighbourhood that fits the policy guidelines



Form a Community Garden Group! Talk to your neighbours, residents adjacent to proposed location and others who might be interested



**Contact your local Community Association** (CA) to determine if they support the idea



Find a non-profit organization to manage and operate the garden (CA, Zone Board, or other)



Create and send your garden proposal to gardens@regina.ca



Review of the garden proposal by **City Community Consultant** 



Meet with City Staff to refine the proposal. If not suitable, City Staff will help the group determine a more suitable location



Preliminary approval and formal City review



Lead the community consultation with support from City Staff



Community approval



**Report to Council** 



Lease agreement signed by the City and the non-profit



Garden construction organized by, managed by, and paid for by the non-profit organization
