## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER LONG-TERM DEBT FINANCING

The City of Regina hereby gives notice, pursuant to sections 101 and 102 of *The Cities Act* and the *Public Notice Policy Bylaw*, Bylaw No. 2003-8, of its intention to consider long-term debt financing for the City's proposed 2019 General Operating and 2019-2023 Capital programs.

City Council will be considering an Operating and Capital Budget that includes borrowing \$12.8 million in 2019 to pay out a debenture that was issued in 2009 pursuant to *The General and Utility Capital Debenture Bylaw 2009*, being Bylaw 2009-34 and \$12 million in 2020 and \$3 million in 2021 to build an outdoor destination aquatic facility. Long-term debt financing will be considered as part of the City's Budgets by Council at the Monday, December 10, 2018 meeting at 5:30 p.m. at Henry Baker Hall, City Hall, and may also be considered at subsequent Council meetings, including December 11, 2018 and December 17, 2018. The specific details of the proposed financing will also come forward at a later date as City Council must pass a bylaw for long term debt financing before the City can issue a debenture or borrow any funds for these proposed debts.
