| Board of Revision | The Board of Revision hears appeals against property tax assessments and makes decisions based on the evidence presented. Hearings are held during the business day. The number of weeks of sittings will be dependent on the number of appeals received. Note: Applicants should have experience in hearing appeals or in meetings that involve an adjudication process, as well as experience with writing decisions. | Up to 3 years | 1 |
| Regina Airport Authority | The Authority is responsible for the operation of the Regina Airport and the management, development and operation of the Airport Properties in a safe, secure, efficient, cost effective and financially viable manner. The Authority will generate, suggest and participate in economic development projects intended to expand Saskatchewan's transportation facilities. Note: No person appointed to the authority can hold a municipal, provincial or federal elected or appointed office, or be employed by any level of government on a full time basis directly or under contract. The appointments are effective May 1, 2019. | Up to 3 years | 2 |
| Regina Public Library Board | The Board is responsible for the operations of public libraries and sets policy for the management of the Regina Public Library, as set out under <i>The Public Libraries Act, 1996</i> . | 2 years | 1 |
