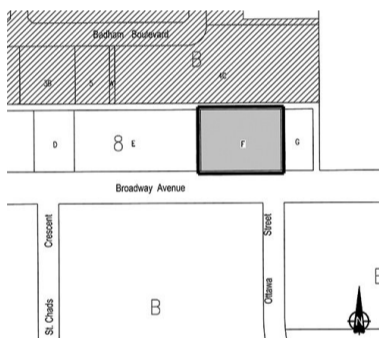

Amendment to Regina Zoning Bylaw No. 9250 – Chapter 19-Zoning Maps (Map No. 2887).

The properties identified and as shown on the map below will be considered for rezoning as follows:



Legal Address: Lot F, Block 8, Plan No. FU1637
Civic Address: 1464 Broadway Avenue
Current Zoning: PS – Public Service
Proposed Zoning: MX – Mixed Residential Business

Reason:

The site used to be the Tartan Curling Club which has now closed. No new development is proposed at this time, but the rezoning will allow for greater flexibility in possible future redevelopment.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER CHANGES TO THE REGINA CITY COUNCIL REMUNERATION BYLAW, 2001

The City of Regina hereby gives notice, pursuant to sections 101 and 102 of *The Cities Act* and *The Public Notice Policy Bylaw*, Bylaw No. 2003-8, of its intention to consider a report and a bylaw which would amend Bylaw 2001-108 being *The Regina City Council Remuneration Bylaw 2001*.

The Executive Committee will be considering an amendment to *The Regina City Council Remuneration Bylaw 2001* for Council approval. Because of the removal of a tax exemption in the *Income Tax Act*, Council member's net pay will be decreased as of January 1, 2019. To avoid this happening, an amendment is recommended that would maintain the Council members' net pay by increasing the Mayor's annual salary to 99.78% of the Provincial Cabinet Minister's salary and reducing the percentage of the Mayor's annual salary for the other members of Council to 30.73%. Particulars of the report and amending bylaw will be considered at the Wednesday, November 14, 2018, Executive Committee meeting at 11:45 a.m. and City Council at its Monday, November 26, 2018, meeting at 5:30 p.m. Both meetings are in Henry Baker Hall, City Hall.
