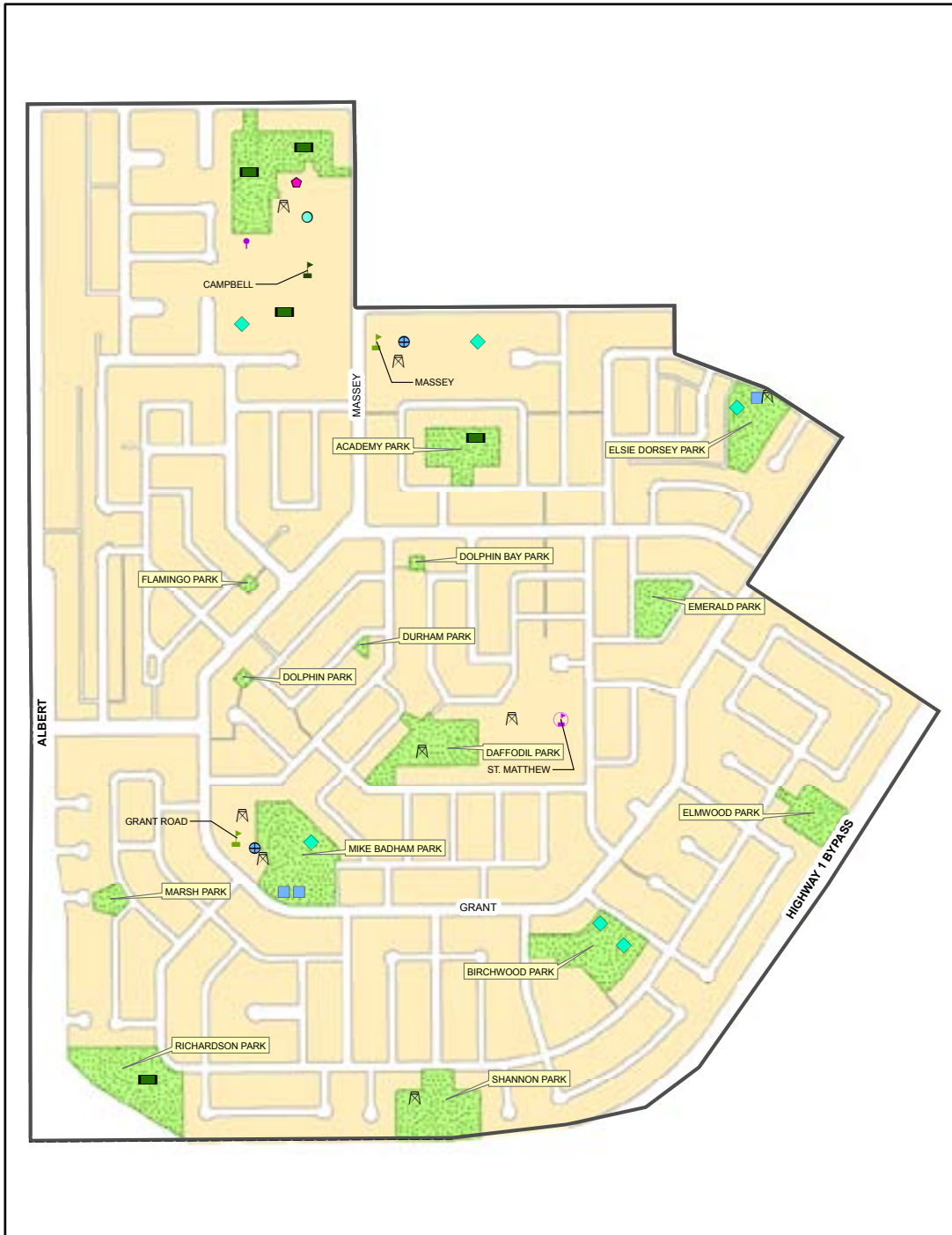
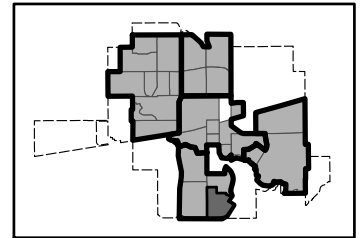

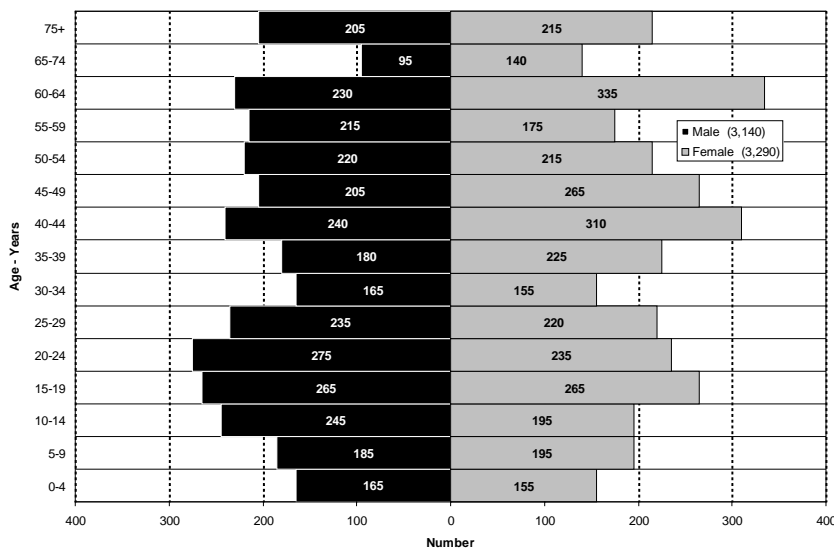
Whitmore Park Neighbourhood

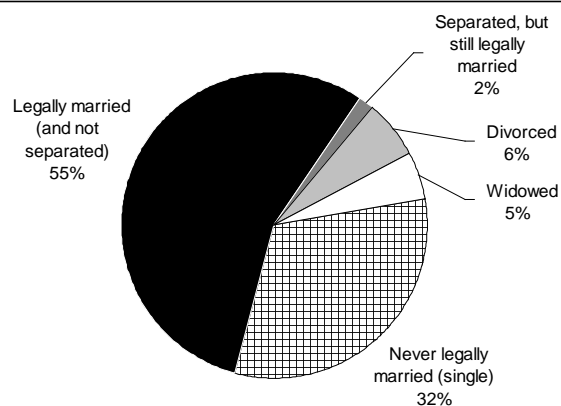


Whitmore Park - Grant Road School

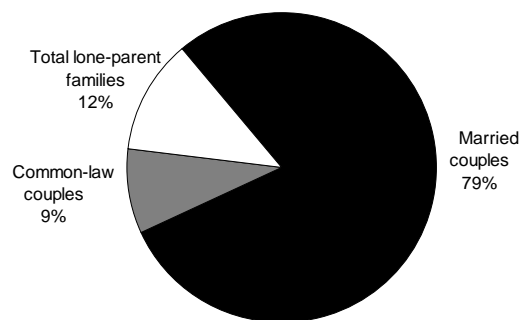

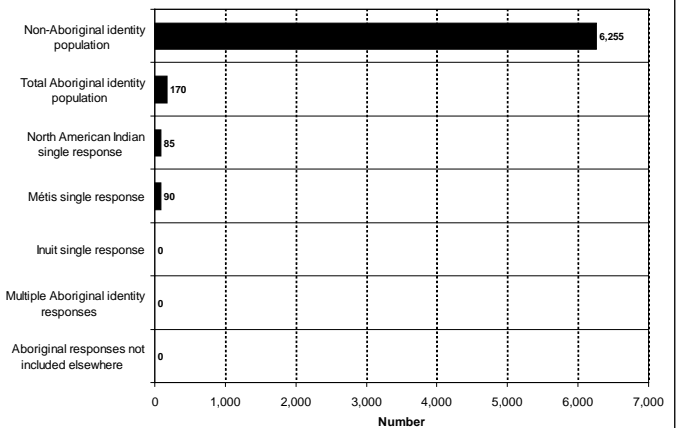

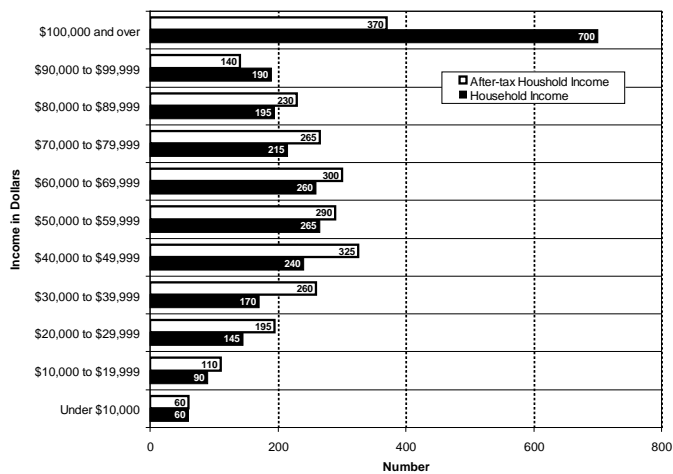

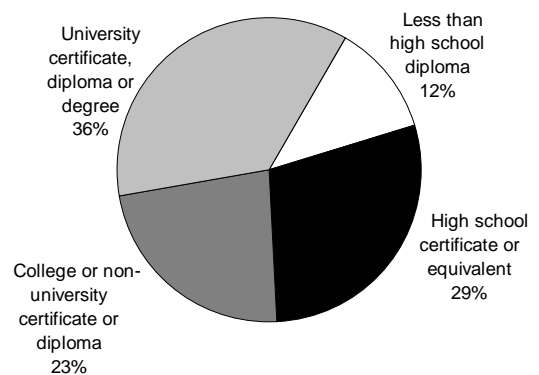

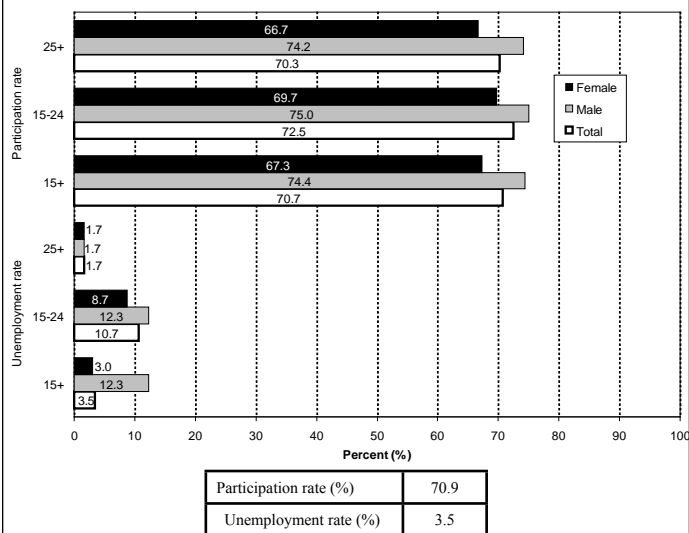

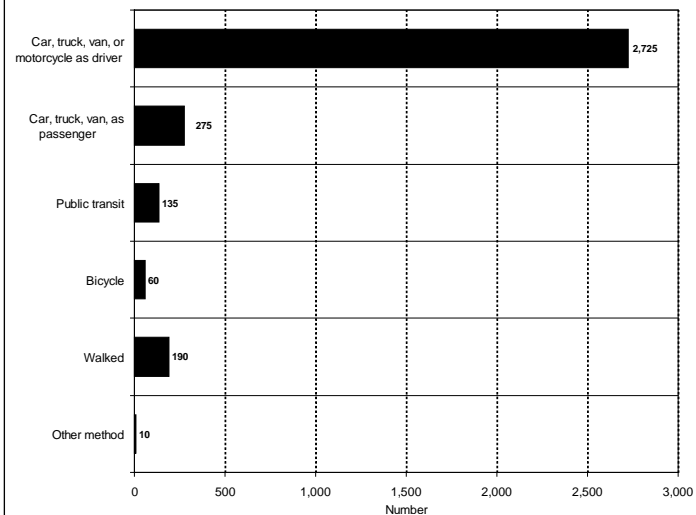

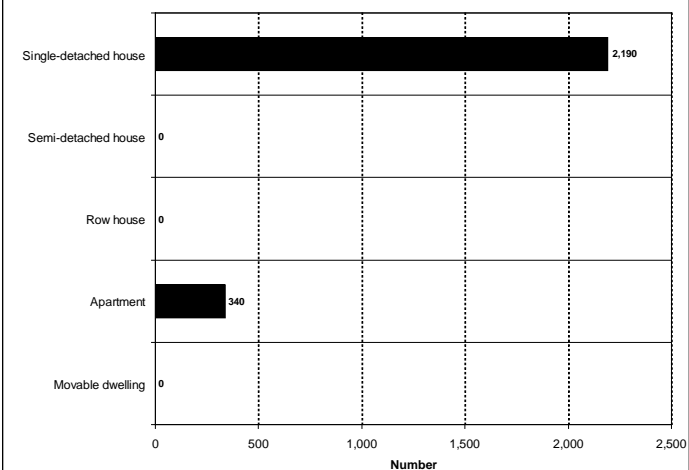
Labour Force Activity (15 years and over)



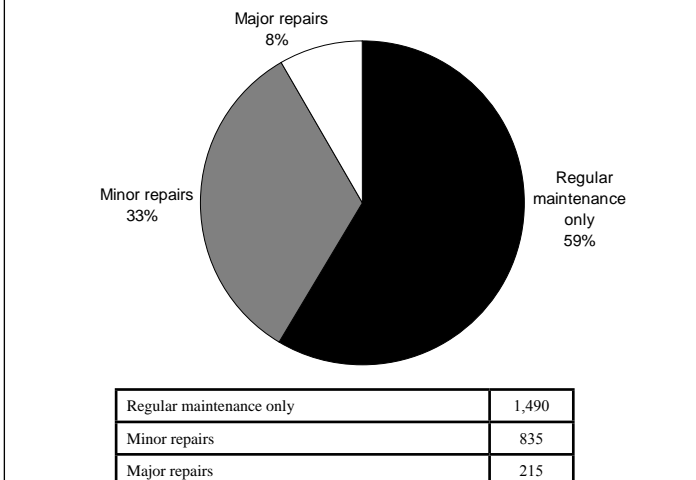
Mode of Transportation (employed labour force)



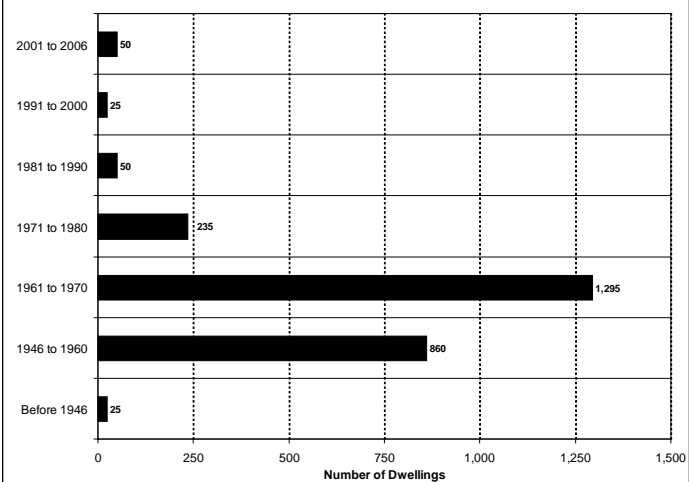
Type of Housing Stock
